- Current Medical or Basic Med as required for Goal sought (not required for Light Sport)

SELECTION

- The winner will be chosen by an independent panel of outside judges and is not based on financial need. The scholarship committee does not choose the winner.
- Consideration will be given for participation in activities that support women in aviation.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Copy of last page of logbook
- Copy of last Flight Review page endorsement or equivalent
- Copy of current Medical Certificate OR Copy of both sides of driver's license if intending to use Sport's pilot privileges
- Copy of Pilot's certificate, both sides
- A one page essay including:
 - What new flight experience/training you wish to learn?
 - o What benefit do you expect to receive?

- O How will you contribute to the Ninety-Nines and/or aviation community?
- Must complete training within 12 months of being awarded the scholarship
- Submission of a completed application form, personal essay, appropriate copies stated above to the Scholarship Committee from May 1 - May15, 2020
- You may apply for only one VC99s scholarship at a time

HOW IS THE AWARD PAID?

Invoice from flight school or CFI required. Scholarship payments will be applied directly to the pilot's flight school account or *qualifying flight instructor. If requesting fuel reimbursement, must submit copies of receipts.

To request payment upon completion of any one of the aviation goals, email a copy of the appropriate page from your log book to Scholarships@VC99s.org. If needed, arrangements can be made to pay flight school or CFI immediately once the training is completed. *If payment to an instructor is requested, the instructor must provide a copy of their current CFI certificate. In the event of unforeseen circumstances where you are unable to complete your aviation goal within one year, (1) three month extension may be granted upon a progress review by the Scholarship Committee.
